Funds for Artists' Resilience (FAR), a project of the Ink People Center for the Arts, is providing artist selection and project management services for a new initiative that will fund public art projects in Humboldt, Del Norte, and Trinity counties on themes of equity and resilience.

The Ink People Center for the Arts, in partnership with the Trinity County Arts Council (TCAC) and Del Norte Association for Cultural Awareness (DNACA), encourage proposals for imaginative multimedia gestures that reflect the unique attributes of this region and the unique challenges community members are facing in these times.

Proposed artworks and events must be accessible to the public, provide opportunities for engagement with members of the community, or be a bridge for uniting diverse populations. Possible approaches include: poetry, music, performance, painting, audiovisual production, and community engagement/social praxis. All media are eligible.
